Winemaker's Tasting Notes:	This perfumed nose is highlight by redcurrant, bing cherry, rose petals, red licorice and coriander laced with notes of vanilla crème brulee with hints of spearmint. A bright raspberry attack gives way to a full mouth of ripe black cherry, boysenberry, aniseed, and mature leather that are all nicely supported by juicy chocolate covered strawberry tannins. The wine lingers with intense blackcurrant, clove, vanilla, and fresh mint.
