Appellation:	Napa Valley, Coombsville District
Vineyard:	Caldwell Vineyard Estate, Established 1981
Elevation:	500 feet above sea level; Hillside, with 5% to 30% slopes
Climate:	The Coombsville region, with its close proximity to the San Pablo Bay, has a very unique climate which allows for an extraordinarily long growing season without the extreme hot and cold temperatures that can be experienced in the rest of the Napa Valley.
Soils:	Shallow soils, 2.5 feet deep, reddish brown in color. Rare to Napa Valley, a combination of volcanic ash, Sobrante loam and stony clay and rocks.
Tasting Notes:	<p>A potpourri of blueberry, cranberry, black cherry, all-spice, and coriander are at the forefront of this formidable nose. Underlying notes of lavender, cloves, cinnamon, and fresh ground white pepper keeps you coming back for more.</p> <p>A powerful attack of black raspberry leads into a huge juicy mouth of cherry, cranberry, strawberry, anise, and black pepper. Bold, integrated tannins of coffee are complemented by refreshing acidity that gives way to a very long finish of black cherry, dark chocolate, and sage.</p>
