Vintage Summary:	<p>The 2015 growing season started with a very early bud break due to a warm fall. Less than ideal conditions during bloom resulted in a challenging set. Warmer conditions continued through an early veraison in July. With the lighter crop the sugars rised faster than anticipated resulting in a historically early harvest.</p> <p>The 2015 vintage had lack of uniformity within the clusters and lighter canopies comparing to 2012, 2013 and 2014.</p> <p>The vineyard yield was down at least 30% across all varieties. The vintage berry sizes varied widely, within varieties, due to the challenging set.</p>
